

**Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Robbery Suspect**

Sevierville, TN – March 10, 2010 – The Sevierville Police and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy robbery that occurred at the CVS Pharmacy located at 718 Winfield Dunn Parkway in Sevierville.

The cash reward is donated by pharmaceutical company Purdue Pharma L.P., which operates RxPATROL[®], a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. Robbery Details for Public Announcement:

The Sevierville Police Department is investigating a pharmacy robbery that occurred at the CVS Pharmacy located at 718 Winfield Dunn Parkway in Sevierville. *Crime Stoppers* and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$1,000, donated by Purdue Pharma L.P., for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Date/Time:** February 15, 2010, 5:30 PM
- **Location:** CVS Pharmacy, 718 Winfield Dunn Parkway Sevierville, TN
- **Description of Events:** A suspect entered the pharmacy through the front door, implied he had a gun and demanded prescription medicines. The suspect fled out the front door and left in a white Ford Ranger pickup truck after he was given an undetermined amount of medicine.
- **Suspect Description:** The suspect is described as a white male, 23–25 years of age, approximately 5’8”-5’10” tall, 180 pounds, with dark hair and brown eyes. He wore a black tweed or wool jacket, blue jeans and a knitted hat. The suspect wore two band aids on his lips, which may have been used to conceal his identity.
