

**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information  
Leading to Arrest of Burglary Suspect(s)**

**Ocean City, Md. –February 4, 2011** – The Ocean City Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy burglary that occurred at Bailey’s Pharmacy, located at 714 Philadelphia Avenue in Ocean City.

The cash reward is donated by pharmaceutical company Purdue Pharma L.P., which operates RxPATROL<sup>®</sup>, a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. The Ocean City Police Department is investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at the Bailey’s Pharmacy located at 714 Philadelphia Avenue, in Ocean City, Maryland. *Crime Stoppers* and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500, donated by Purdue Pharma L.P., for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Description of Events:** Suspect(s) entered the store by removing a rear air conditioner then pried a door to gain access into the pharmacy area. Once inside, the suspect(s) took prescription medicines and all the surveillance equipment in the pharmacy.
