

**Up to \$5,000 Reward Offered for Information  
Leading to Arrest of Robbery Suspect(s)**

**Farmingville, NY – October 10, 2011-** The Suffolk County Police Department and Crime Stoppers of Suffolk County are offering a cash reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) believed to be responsible for a pharmacy robbery that occurred at CVS Pharmacy, located at 935 Horseblock Road in Farmingville.

The cash reward is made possible through a partnership between Crime Stoppers of Suffolk County and pharmaceutical company [Purdue Pharma L.P.](#), which operates RxPATROL<sup>®</sup>, a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. **Robbery Details for Public Announcement:**

The Suffolk County Police Department is investigating a pharmacy robbery that occurred at the CVS Pharmacy, located at 935 Horseblock Road in Farmingville. Law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering [a reward of up to \\$5,000, donated in part by Purdue Pharma L.P.](#), for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Date/Time:** Sunday, June 26, 2011, Approx. 12:15pm
- **Location:** CVS Pharmacy, 935 Horseblock Road, Farmingville, NY 11738
- **Description of Events:** Suspect entered the pharmacy through the front door and left a short time later. He returned and passed a note demanding cash and controlled substances. The suspect fled out the front door after being given an undetermined amount of cash and medicine.
- **Suspect Description:** White male, in his early twenties, approximately 5’8”, with a thin build. He wore a gray hooded sweatshirt, red and white baseball cap and dark colored pants.
