

**Up to \$2,500 Reward Offered for Information
Leading to Arrest of Robbery Suspect**

Westminster, MD – January 26, 2012 - The Westminster Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$2,500 for information leading to the arrest of the suspects believed to be responsible for a pharmacy robbery that occurred at Anchor Pharmacy & Medical Supply, located at 205 Washington Heights Medical Center in Westminster.

The cash reward is donated by pharmaceutical company [Purdue Pharma L.P.](#), which operates RxPATROL®, a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. “It’s important for people to know that all information that we get is kept completely confidential. Callers never have to give their names or appear in court. The Crime Stoppers tip line does not use any tape recording or caller ID devices,” said Crime Stoppers Chairperson, Gene Ferrara.

Robbery Details for Public Announcement:

The Westminster Police Department is investigating a pharmacy robbery that occurred at Anchor Pharmacy & Medical Supply, located at 205 Washington Heights Medical Center in Westminster. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering [a reward of up to \\$2,500, donated by Purdue Pharma L.P.](#) for any information that will help solve this crime.

- **Date/Time:** Friday, December 30, 2011, approximately 7:10pm
- **Location:** Anchor Pharmacy & Medical Supply, 205 Washington Heights Medical Center, Westminster, Maryland
- **Description of Events:** Suspect entered the pharmacy through the front door, went to the pharmacy counter, displayed a handgun and demanded prescription medicine. The suspect fled out the front door after being given an undetermined amount of controlled substances. Law enforcement believes the same suspect may be responsible for robbing this location on October 24, 2011.
- **Suspect Description:** Suspect is described as a white male, weighing approximately 250 pounds and 6’ tall. He wore a dark knit hat, black ski mask, dark blue sweatshirt and sweatpants.
