## **Robbery Details for Public Announcement:**

The Omaha Police Department and Crime Stoppers are investigating a pharmacy robbery that occurred at the CVS Pharmacy, located at 1919 North 90<sup>th</sup> Street. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public's assistance by offering a reward of up to \$2,500 for any information that will help solve this crime. The reward is donated by RxPATROL.

- **Date/Time:** Wednesday, May 7, 2014, approximately 1:46am
- Location: CVS Pharmacy, located at 1919 North 90<sup>th</sup> Street, Omaha, NE
- **Description of Events:** Officers responded to a radio call to the CVS Pharmacy to investigate a robbery. The employee told officers that the suspect entered the store and initially went to the bathroom. The suspect exited the bathroom, displayed a firearm and demanded prescription medications. After receipt of the prescription drug the suspect fled on foot to the east.
- **Suspect Description:** White male wearing a white shirt, blue jeans, stocking cap and blue mask.
