

**Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered for Information  
Leading to Arrest of Burglary Suspect**

**Indianapolis, IN – January 23, 2014** – The Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department and Crime Stoppers are offering a cash reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest of the suspect believed to be responsible for a pharmacy burglary that occurred at the CVS Pharmacy, located at 5502 West 38<sup>th</sup> Street in Indianapolis.

The cash reward is donated by RxPATROL<sup>®</sup>, a collaborative effort between industry, pharmacists and law enforcement to collect, collate, analyze and disseminate information on pharmacy theft. **Burglary Details for Public Announcement:**

The Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department is investigating a pharmacy burglary that occurred at the CVS Pharmacy located at 5502 West 38<sup>th</sup> Street in Indianapolis. Crime Stoppers and law enforcement officials are asking for the public’s assistance by offering a reward of up to \$1,000 for any information that will help solve this crime. The reward is donated by RxPATROL.

- **Date/Time:** Tuesday, January 14, 2014, approx. 2:06am
- **Location:** CVS Pharmacy, 5502 West 38<sup>th</sup> Street, Indianapolis, Indiana
- **Description of Events:** Suspect used a concrete paver to smash the drive-up window to gain entry into the pharmacy. The suspect fled after taking an undetermined amount of prescription medication.
- **Suspect Description:** Suspect is described as a black male, thin build wearing a black zip-up jacket over a grey hoodie, black jeans over red shorts, one white glove, one blue glove and black and white tennis shoes. Security photos are attached.
